



# Georgia's Home Energy Rebates

## Required Document Checklist

Georgia's Home Energy Rebates' participants must provide the documentation detailed below to complete their online application. **If you do not provide this documentation, your application will not be processed.**

Before you apply, please make sure you have a working telephone number and personal email address.

### Required Documents

Provide the following documents for your household:

PRIMARY IDENTIFICATION (Pick 1)

PROOF OF RESIDENCY (Pick 2)

<input type="checkbox"/> Postmarked mail delivered by the U.S. Postal Service, dated within the past 3 months	<input type="checkbox"/> Recent motor vehicle registration or insurance policy
<input type="checkbox"/> Government-issued documents (e.g., Annual Benefits statement, Income Tax Returns, assistance documents such as Medicare, Medicaid, Voter Registration card, and other documents issued by Federal/State/Municipal government)	<input type="checkbox"/> Recent W-2 or 2 pay stubs dated within the last 60 days
	<input type="checkbox"/> School record/transcript for the current or prior school year, report card, student loan documentation, or form DS-1.

### Examples of two forms of proof of residency:

- Documents should be within the last three (3) months
- Name(s) on documents should match a household member
- Property address should be the building listed in the rebate application

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### Income Eligibility

Both HEAR and HER use household income as part of an eligibility review. Participants can either use Categorical Eligibility (i.e., participation in a select public benefit program) or provide program-approved income documentation to complete their application.

### Examples of income verification documentation:

- Tax documents should be within the last year
- Pay stubs or bank statements should be dated within the last 60 days
